**STRAIN TALK**

**Grand Shadoobie Purple**

**O**riginating in Northern California, this pure Indica is easy to work with throughout her growth cycle. Flowers in 8-9 weeks. Harvests in mid-October. This plant is very medicinal, providing relief to many cancer and chemotherapy patients. For an Indica, its effects are surprisingly energetic rather than sedating. *Grand Shadoobie* has a sweet, skunky aroma and a very sweet grape taste.



**California Supreme Court Strikes Limits for Medical Marijuana Patients**

**I**n October of 2005, a medical marijuana patient named Patrick Kelly was arrested for barely overstepping the state limits of no more than 8 ounces and 6 mature or 12 immature plants. On January 21st, 2010, the California Supreme Court rejected state-imposed limits on medical cannabis possession or cultivation in the *People v. Kelly* decision. A unanimous decision was made that the limits set in 2003 were ruled unconstitutional, as the *Compassionate Use Act* (CUA) passed by California voters in 1996 did not set any such quantitative standards.

This legislation is designed to allow patients (and their primary caregivers), with state-issued identification cards, to possess any "medically-reasonable" amount of cannabis. However, there is some concern that the absence of specified amounts will leave too much power in the hands of law enforcement, especially those officials who are not tolerant of medical marijuana policies. Nevertheless, patient rights protected by the CUA remain in place and this should continue to prevent prosecution of legal medical marijuana cultivators and consumers.

**Recipe of the Month**

**Medicated Sweetheart Scones**

**INGREDIENTS:**

- 2 cups all purpose flour
- 1/3 cup sugar
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 5 Tbsp. chilled canna-butter, cut into 1/2-inch pieces
- 1 cup plus 3 tablespoons whipping cream
- 1/3 cup of your favorite jam (do not use seedless)
- 1/2 cup powdered sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon rose water (optional)

**PREPARATION:**

- Preheat oven to 400°F. Mix flour, sugar, baking powder, and 1/2 teaspoon salt in large bowl. Add butter; rub in with fingertips until mixture resembles fine meal.
- Gradually add 1 cup cream, mixing until dough comes together. Turn dough out onto sheet of foil; pat to 1/2-inch thickness.
- Using 3-inch heart-shaped or round cookie cutter, cut out scones. Gather scraps; pat to 1/2-inch thickness and cut out more scones.
- Using a floured knife, start



- at the point of each heart and cut horizontally halfway through scones; fill with a generous teaspoon of jam (jam will show at edges).
- Transfer to baking sheet. Bake scones until brown, about 18 minutes. Transfer to rack; cool scones until slightly warm.
- Mix powdered sugar, remaining 3 tablespoons cream, and rose water in bowl to blend. Spread glaze over scones. Serve slightly or at room temperature.

### OrganiCann Recommends Getting a State I.D.

**A**mericans for Safe Access (ASA), a medical marijuana rights organization, supports the program but points out that California law specifies (and the DHS reiterates) participation in the ID program is voluntary for patients and the patient's primary caregiver.
